We investigated the occurrence and localization of estrogen and progesterone receptors in the anogenital region of pregnant baboons. Both immunohistochemistry and in situ hybridization were used for the localization and measurement of estrogen receptors (ER) and progesterone receptors (PgR). Immunohistochemistry revealed positive staining for both ER and PgR in the epithelial and stromal cells of the epithelium, as well as in the endometrium, myometrium, and cervix. Stroma staining was most intense in the cervix. In situ hybridization revealed immunohistochemically positive epithelial and stromal cells in the cervix, endometrium, and myometrium. Both the epithelial and stromal cells in the cervix were most intense. No receptors were detected in the endocervix. In the vagina of pregnant baboons, receptors were found in the epithelium and endocervix, but not in the stroma. In the perivulva region, both epithelial and stromal cells were found. The amount of ER and PgR staining was most intense in cervixes of nonpregnant baboons, which was much less in pregnant baboons. The present study demonstrates for the first time the presence of both receptors in epithelial and stromal cells of the cervix of pregnant baboons. The fact that the uterus in the pregnant animal is also positively stained suggests that estrogens and progesterone may be involved in the fetal maturation of the cervix.
