If you're new here, you might want to read our AutoCAD Beginner Guide or the full AutoCAD Beginner's Guide, which is more detailed than our other AutoCAD guides. AutoCAD comes in two versions: AutoCAD LT (for beginners) and AutoCAD 2018 (for more experienced users). Both versions have almost the same features but the differences are explained in the AutoCAD Beginner's Guide. Here we focus on the essentials that would help you work efficiently in AutoCAD. As a general rule, AutoCAD can be used for more than just drafting, including 2D and 3D design. AutoCAD Basics Downloading AutoCAD AutoCAD 2018 can be downloaded from the Autodesk website. AutoCAD LT requires a serial number and an Internet connection (or a locally-installed CD-ROM of AutoCAD LT). Click here to get AutoCAD LT Serial Number or Manual. Getting Started Autodesk offers a free 30-day trial of AutoCAD LT so you can work on the things you want without worrying about paying the full price. The AutoCAD menu will contain 2 tabs: Math and Drawing. To use the drawing tools in AutoCAD, you need to: Select the Drawing tab and press 'R' to start the drawing. To work on the drawing, use either the mouse or your finger to draw. You can draw straight lines or by clicking and dragging to draw the freehand (freehand drawing). To align to a grid or draw a polyline, press Shift+'R' to use a new tool, called the Direct Selection tool. To snap a line, hold down Shift while drawing a line. To copy a line or another drawing element, press Alt+'R' to use a copy tool. To delete a drawing element, click and drag it to the trash. To zoom, click the Zoom tool. If you don't see the Zoom tool, make sure that the drawing panel and drawing view are set to fit. To pan, click and drag the drawing window left or right. To reposition, click and drag the drawing window up or down. To make your drawing fit within the window, click the Fit To window button in the status bar or go to View > Fit To Window.

With the introduction of AutoCAD 2008, the warranty period was extended to five years, supporting AutoCAD software. A trademark application was filed in Australia. On August 24, 2009, Autodesk filed suit against AcRage for trademark infringement in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of New York. The suit was filed after AcRage re-launched the software, called Revolution, with new branding. Autodesk contended that AcRage violated the agreement with Autodesk and the existing trademark registration by re-launching the product and referring to it as the "Autocad for Revolution". Autodesk said it would seek "legal costs and damages." On August 24, 2010, Autodesk filed a second lawsuit against AcRage, this time for trademark infringement in California. The suit was filed after AcRage re-launched the software, called Revolution, with new branding. Autodesk contended that AcRage was using a logo that was strikingly similar to the original logo for AutoCAD, violating the agreement with Autodesk and the existing trademark registration. Autodesk said it would seek "legal costs and damages." On February 11, 2011, Autodesk settled with AcRage for US\$100,000.
